1. **Primo Prosecco** £19.95
Trentino, Italy
Its colour is brilliant pale straw yellow, the bouquet has a delicate floral and fruit quality, slightly savoury & smooth. (1)
2. **Portecelli Cava Brut** £20.95
Spain
Vigorous with a fine mousse and flavours of orange, grapefruit, lemon and biscuity hints. (1)
3. **House Champagne** £34.95
Reims, France
Fresh, fruity & bright with a subtle herbal edge to the zippy fruit, as well as some citrus notes. Nicely balanced. (1)
4. **Laurent Perrier Champagne** £59.95
Tours-Sur-Marne, France
Subtle citrus, toast and spice predominate this perfectly balanced Champagne, with a strong structure giving the wine good food compatibility. (1)

Veneto, Italy £4.25 (175ml glass)
Light, crisp & fruity. (2) £5.75 (250ml glass)
6. **Cape 312 Chenin Blanc** £16.75 (75cl bottle)
Western Cape, S. Africa £4.50 (175ml glass)
Medium bodied with citrus, grapefruit & plum aromas. (3) £5.95 (250ml glass)
7. **Las Montanas Sauvignon Blanc** £16.95
Valle Central, Chile
Refreshing blend of citrus & apple flavours. (2)
8. **Auction House Chardonnay** £17.75
South East Australia, Australia
Citrus & vanilla flavours with a full strong finish. (2)
9. **Sentina Soave** £19.95
Veneto, Italy
Straw yellow in colour, this Soave is light & delicate with a young and fruity flavour and a crisp citrus finish with a hint of almonds. (2)
10. **Rongopai Pinot Gris** £24.95
Marlborough, New Zealand
This has a full nose of white and yellow stone fruits showing a little savoury interest & nuances of nuts and minerals. (2)
11. **Sancerre** £29.95
Loire, France
Refreshing minerality with apple, citrus fruit & floral notes. (1)
12. **Chablis** £32.50
Burgundy, France
Full of good mineral acidity gooseberry fruit & herbaceous aromas. Fresh, crisp & persistent on the palate with a lovely long finish. (1)

Veneto, Italy £4.25 (175ml glass)
Fruity, pleasantly sourish flavour. (2) £5.75 (250ml glass)
14. **Pacific Heights Rose** £17.50
California, USA
Medium sweet bursting with succulent scented strawberries & cream fruit flavours. (5)

15. **Versare Merlot** £16.25 (75cl bottle)
Veneto, Italy £4.25 (175ml glass)
Plum & red berry fruits. (B) £5.75 (250ml glass)
16. **Cape 312 Pinotage** £16.75 (75cl bottle)
Western Cape, S. Africa £4.50 (175ml glass)
Velvety with cherry flavours & a hint of spice on the finish. (D) £5.95 (250ml glass)
17. **Las Montanas Cabernet Sauvignon** £16.95
Valle Central, Chile
Smooth with ripe blackcurrant jammy flavours leading to a long almost spicy finish. (C)
18. **Auction House Shiraz** £17.75
South East Australia, Australia
Soft tannins & a lingering fruit driven finish. (C)
19. **Carrizal Rioja Tempranillo** £19.95
La Rioja, Spain
A bouquet of cherries & plums. The smooth as silk texture & upfront fruit make this delicious. (C)
20. **Sentina Chianti** £21.50
Tuscany, Italy
It has a fine, persistent bouquet, with notes of cherries & wild berries & underlying spicy notes with bottle age. (C)
21. **Marquez de Caceres Crianza Rioja** £24.95
La Rioja, Spain
Intense bouquet that brings to mind jelly made from fruits of the forest & sweet spice. Good concentration in the mouth with delicious tannins & rich complex fruit. (D)
22. **Babich Pinot Noir** £26.50
Marlborough, New Zealand
Aromas of wild strawberry & cherry. Dark cedar notes with a hint of mint and dried herbs. (B)
23. **Angelo Veglio Barolo** £34.50
Piedmont, Italy
Light in colour with ripe rich fruit aromas and flavours. The wine possesses rose & anise scented aromatics and deep flavours of cherry, orange peel and subtle green herb tones. (D)
24. **Châteauneuf du Pape** £39.50
Rhône Valley, France
This wine is dark ruby with a complex nose of spices & hints of pear. A smooth & lingering finish. (E)

Taste Guide

In brackets following the wines description:

White/Rose/Sparkling Wine – rated 1 – 9
1 is the driest & 9 is the sweetest

Red Wine – rated A – E
A is the lightest & E the most full bodied
